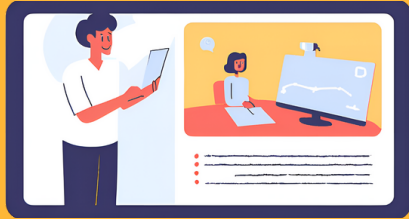


Get ready to collaborate
